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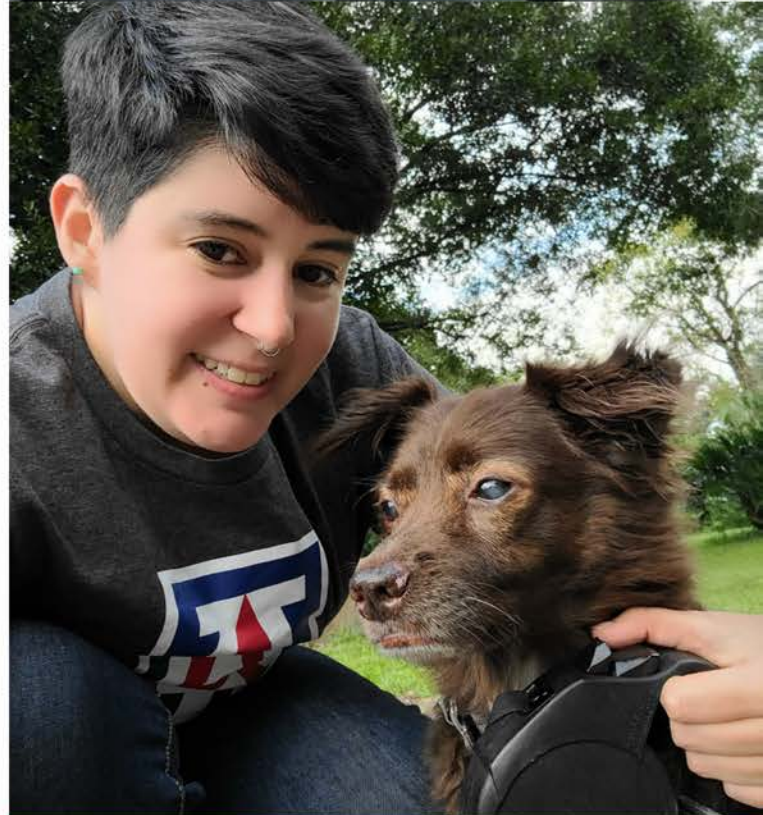

Mapping the quickest route out of the storm in advance will bring peace of mind.



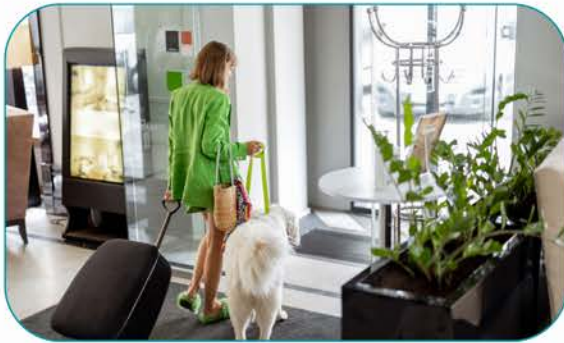
3. Create a safe place
